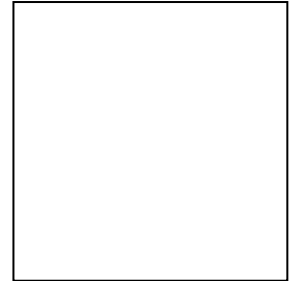

INSTRUCTIONS

Rules for Admissions to the D.Ed (Hearing Impairment) Course in Sweekaar Academy of Rehabilitation Sciences.

1. Eligibility : 10+2/12 th Std. or equivalent
2. Duration of course : Two academic years (Semester System)
3. No. of Seats : 25
4. Age : While no minimum and maximum age is permitted preference will be given to those below 35 years of age.
5. Medium of Instruction : National/Regional Language/English
6. Hostel will be provided on payment if required.
7. Candidates who apply under reservation shall produce the caste certificate issued by M.R.O concerned.
8. a) Fee Rs.10, 000 /- for first year.
b) Fee Rs.12, 000 /- for second year.
9. The candidates have to bear the expenditure for practical records etc.
10. Course comprises of practical and theory subjects as per the syllabus prescribed by the Rehabilitation council of India.
11. The original certificates of the candidates should be submitted when they seek admission and they will be returned on completion of training only. Xerox copies may also be enclosed with the application form.
12. Application form should be filled up by the candidate with own handwriting neatly.
13. Exam will be conducted by the Rehabilitation Council of India or as per directions of R.C.I
14. All students shall adhere to the Institutional rules and isolation of rules will be viewed seriously.

15. Leave:

All the students are eligible for 10 days casual leaves in a year. No candidates will be permitted to appear for exams unless he/she fulfills the minimum attendance required as per rules.

16. In all cases the orders of the Chairman will be final
